**SECURE CAR PARK TERMS AND CONDITIONS**  
**Katowice Airport in Pyrzowice**

## **§1**

The Secure Car Park forms an integral part of Katowice International Airport in Pyrzowice, which is managed by the Upper Silesian Aviation Group (henceforth GTL) in Katowice at Al. Korfantego 38, 40-161. KRS 0000023650, NIP 634-012-80-15, tel. +48 32 39 27 202.

## **§2**

The Car Park, under the management of GTL, is a secure car park and parking tariffs apply.

## **§3**

A vehicle user, upon entering the car park, expresses agreement and agrees to adhere to the terms and conditions bound within this document.

## **§4**

The contract with GTL regarding the rental of car space refers only to the vehicle itself and its factory fittings.

## **§5**

GTL accepts liability only if the vehicle shows visible signs of breaking in - pertaining to the, destruction, damage or theft from the vehicle or the contents of the vehicle, other than factory fittings, only if GTL accepted the vehicle despite having been informed of the vehicle containing items not usually identified with the vehicle usage.

## **§6**

Upon entering the Car Park, customers must stop their vehicles at the Car Park reception area. By accepting a magnetic card from Car Park staff, customers agree to enter into contract with GTL and abide by regulations regarding parking permits - seasonal pass or hourly rate.

## **§7**

Prior to leaving a vehicle at the Car Park, customers are required to present the vehicle, its security system and (if deemed necessary by Car Park staff) registration details and to report:

- a. all existing damage to the vehicle as well as missing fittings or equipment,
- b. additional exterior fittings such as antenna, hubcaps, windscreen wipers, fog lights etc.

## **§8**

The magnetic card issued by GTL entitles the holder to utilise one car park space.

## **§9**

Magnetic cards must not, under any circumstances, be left inside the vehicle, nor be transferred to third parties. The card must not be destroyed or bent in any way, shape or form.

## **§10**

Upon entering the Car Park in order to reclaim a vehicle, the magnetic card must be produced to Car Park staff.

## **§11**

Upon exiting the Car Park, customers are required to stop at the Car Park reception, provide all necessary documentation for the legal exit of the Car Park – magnetic card and registration, papers should they be required, and payment for parking.

## **§12**

Vehicle users who have left their vehicles in the Car Park over the time limit for which they have pre-paid will be required to supplement this payment in accordance with the list of tariffs and charges provided by GTL.

### **§13**

Persons in possession of a valid magnetic card will be assumed by GTL to be legitimate vehicle users and will be allowed drive a vehicle and exit the Car Park with the vehicle.

### **§14**

In the case of loss of magnetic card, vehicle users will only be able to exit the Car Park with their vehicles upon providing registration papers and official personal identification. Should a person, not in possession of a valid magnetic card, refuse to provide some form of official personal identification, Car Park staff are required to notify police.

### **§15**

Any attempts by customers to enter their vehicles, in the case of customers having lost their keys or having locked them in their vehicles, will only be permitted upon their production of registration papers for this vehicle, together with some form of official personal identification.

### **§16**

The list of parking tariffs and charges is provided as an appendix to this document of terms and conditions.

### **§17**

The list of tariffs and charges is available for from Car Park staff and is also provided for customers in a clearly marked and visible location within the Car Park.

### **§18**

Payment for parking is calculated by computer and collected upon exiting the Car Park. Parking charges are accrued on the basis of magnetic card reader which registers the date and hour the customer entered into contract with GTL.

### **§19**

People under the influence of alcohol or substances inhibiting reactions, or people whose behaviour indicates the consumption of alcohol or substances inhibiting reactions, may be refused entry into the Car Park or may be refused the reissue of their vehicle.

### **§20**

Vehicle users are required secure their vehicles to prevent unauthorised entry by third persons. GTL is not liable for the theft or loss of any items remaining in the vehicle should the vehicle not be locked, with any available security systems not in place.

### **§21**

The Car Park area, entry and exit points are monitored by Car Park staff and security services.

### **§22**

The Car Park is open every day of the year. Cars are accepted into and permitted to exit the Car Park 24 hours a day.

### **§23**

A speed limit of 10km/hr applies within the area bound by the Car Park. All access and internal roads, as well as the area bound by the Car Park are subject to road and traffic regulations as per Dz.U. (Journal of Laws) 2005, No. 108, item 908, including subsequent modifications.

### **§24**

Vehicle users are required to adhere to and abide by all road traffic signs within the Car Park as well as all internal and access roads. Vehicle users are also required to abide and adhere to all instructions of Car Park staff and other authorised personnel (Airport Security, Police).

## **§25**

Vehicles transporting flammable, caustic, explosive or other hazardous materials are prohibited from entering the Car Park, should the hazardous materials not be stowed or secured in accordance with legally binding regulations.

## **§26**

All instances of damage on vehicles whilst performing parking manoeuvres must immediately be reported to the Police as well as the car park staff.

## **§27**

Vehicle users are required to immediately report all instances of damage executed to their vehicle, or no later than prior to exiting the Car Park.

## **§28**

Vehicle users are liable for any damage performed to third persons within GTL Car Parks by themselves, their staff, persons subcontracted by them and/or accompanying persons. Vehicle users will also be held responsible for contaminating the Car Park areas.

## **§29**

In instances of sudden and justified instances of security threat or emergencies, GTL reserves the right to remove any vehicles from the Car Park.

## **§30**

GTL will not made liable for damage posed by 'acts of God', nor will it be liable for damage posed to vehicles where customers have not abided by the rules and regulations listed within this document.

## **§31**

Vehicle users may not repair or wash or vacuum vehicles within the Car Park or contaminate the Car Park in any way, shape or form, on internal roads or on access ramps. Vehicle users

are not permitted to perform any changes of oil or any other vehicular liquids within the Car Park.

### **§32**

Upon request, GTL is able to issue VAT invoices for Car Park usage. Vehicle users are required to contact Car Park reception within 7 (seven) days of finalising their contract with GTL. Upon provision of written statement, together with Car Park receipt, the invoice may be mailed to a given address.

### **§33**

Claims regarding vehicular damage within the Secure Car Park, for which GTL assumes responsibility, will be resolved by the Car Park's insurance. Contact details are available from the Car Park dispatcher.

### **§34**

All complaints and proposals regarding the Secure Car Park shall be directed to GTL.

### **§35**

These Terms and Conditions are valid from 1st September 2008 and ratified by the GTL Management (Nr 41/VIII/2008) 28th August 2008.
