## PASSENGERS AND CABIN BAGGAGE

**Without prejudice to applicable safety rules, passengers are not permitted to carry the following items into security restricted areas and on board an aircraft.**

### FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS

- a. guns, firearms and other devices that discharge projectiles – devices capable, or appearing capable of being used to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile, including:
  - firearms of all types, such as pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns
  - toy guns, replicas and imitation firearms capable of being mistaken for real weapons
  - component parts of firearms, excluding telescopic sights
  - compressed air and CO<sub>2</sub>, guns such as pistols, pellet guns, rifles and ball bearing guns
  - signal flare pistols and starter pistols
  - bows, cross bows and arrows
  - harpoon guns and spear guns
  - slingshots and catapults.

### DEVICES FOR STUNNING OR IMMOBILIZING

- b. stunning devices – devices designed specifically to stun or immobilize, including:
  - devices for shocking, such as stun guns, tasers and stun batons
  - animal stunners and animal killers
  - disabling and incapacitating chemicals, gases and sprays, such as mace, pepper gas, capsicum sprays, tear gas, acid sprays and animal repellent sprays.

### OBJECTS WITH A SHARP POINTS OR SHARP EDGE

- c. Objects with a sharp point or sharp edge – objects with a sharp point or sharp edge capable of being used to cause serious injury, including:
  - items designed for chopping, such as axes, hatchets and cleavers
  - ice axes and ice picks
  - razor blades
  - box cutters
  - knives with blades of more than 6 cm, (EN L 55/16 Official Journal. Office. European Union 5.3.2010)

- scissors with blades more than 6 cm as measured from the fulcrum
- martial arts equipment with a sharp point or sharp edge,
- swords and sabers.

### WORKMEN'S TOOLS

- d. Workmen's tools – tools capable of being used either to cause serious injury, or to threaten the safety of aircraft, including:
  - crowbars
  - drills and drill bits, including cordless portable power drills
  - tools with a blade or a shaft of more than 6 cm capable of use as a weapon, such as screwdrivers and chisels
  - saws, including cordless portable power saws
  - blowtorches
  - bolt guns and nail guns.

### BLUNT INSTRUMENTS

- e. Blunt instruments – objects capable of being used to cause serious injury when used to hit, including:
  - baseball and softball bats
  - clubs and batons, such as billy clubs, blackjacks and night sticks
  - martial arts equipment.

### EXPLOSIVES AND INCENDIARY SUBSTANCES AND DEVICES

- f. Explosives and incendiary substances and devices – explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable, or appearing capable of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of the aircraft, including:
  - ammunition
  - blasting caps
  - detonators and fuses
  - replica or imitation explosive devices
  - mines, grenades and other explosive military stores
  - fireworks and other pyrotechnics
  - smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating canisters
  - dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives.

## CHECKED BAGGAGE

**Passengers are not permitted to carry the following articles in their hold baggage:**

Explosives and incendiary substances and devices – explosives and incendiary substances and devices capable, or appearing capable of being used to cause serious injury or to pose a threat to the safety of the aircraft, including:

- ammunition
- blasting caps

- detonators and fuses
- replica or imitation explosive devices
- mines, grenades and other explosive military stores
- fireworks and other pyrotechnics
- smoke-generating canisters and smoke-generating canisters
- dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives.
